Vendor Check-ins

1. Cleanslate

- a. Trash liners are being ordered and replaced and cigarette recycling cans are being emptied and cleaned
- b. Milwaukee Ave. planters are being repainted
- c. Bump-outs along Milwaukee Ave. have been power washed

2. Christy Webber

- a. Weekly service has just begun and tree pit mulching will begin this week
- b. The outcropping stone was installed on North Ave. damaged planter fence
- c. Summer planting will go in around May 15th and will coordinate some of the plants into the Worker Cottage planters
- d. MS will look into adding signage to the Worker Cottage to prevent dog waste or people walking though so plants have the chance to grow this season

3. Bartlett

- a. EG presented a brief synopsis of the 2021 Inventory Management Plan
- b. Many of the Ash Trees that they have been treating since the last 2013 inventory are still alive
- c. The Plan recommends the removal of 72 trees
- d. Spring fertilization/pruning and the Ash Tree treatments are complete
- e. The team will be completing the pruning of Ashland Ave within the next month

4. Fence Painting RFP

- a. The committee reviewed the draft RFP to be published online – they will vote next month on applicants to complete the work.

5. Fence Repair on Damen and Lemoyne

- a. There is damaged planter fencing at the corner due to an accident and rust.

- a. AH discussed the new program with the Committee to begin for our 2021 Holiday Season.

- b. Staff would confirm that residents or business owners picking up strands were within SSA boundaries to participate.
