Updates

1. Division St. Fencing Repairs with Americana Iron Works
 - a. Commission approved additional funding in October for crews to replace disintegrated sections of fencing – work to start soon
2. Metzger Court Updates
 - a. Cleanslate continues to service the plaza daily. There have been less complaints of negative loitering or trash since the tables have been installed.
 - b. A trash can with a lid will be purchased once it's back in stock.
 - c. Three additional tables have been ordered and are currently in Cleanslate's storage. Two tables will be installed and one will be stored as a backup/replacement.

 - a. Crews continue to maintain sidewalks.
 - b. Several unoccupied storefronts on Milwaukee Ave. have been badly tagged and required in depth graffiti removal services
