- 1. Division St. Fencing Repairs with Americana Iron Works
  - a. The contract has been signed with Americana and crews will begin work in early Spring –
    WJ would like them to hold off on welding new fencing until early Spring months
- Metzger Court Updates
  - a. An additional table and two new garbage cans have been installed by Cleanslate they have one extra table in storage for us as well
  - b. CDOT has repaired the planter and replaced the tree
  - c. LK will look into paint for the blue benches to prevent any rusting
- 3. Trash Cans
  - a. AH will be working with the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Ward to replace and rusted trash cans in the early Spring.
