Proposals

Motion 1: The Clean & Green Committee moves to approve funding not to exceed **\$52,500** from line item **(2.02 Landscaping)** for Christy Webber Landscaping to provide general landscaping services throughout 2022. (22-0104)

Motion 2: The Clean & Green Committee moves to approve funding not to exceed **\$42,000** from line item **(2.02 Landscaping)** for Christy Webber Landscaping to provide seasonal plantings landscaping services for the Milwaukee Ave. planters throughout 2022. (22-0105)

Motion 3: The Clean & Green Committee moves to approve funding not to exceed **\$48,500** from line item **(2.02 Landscaping)** for Bartlett Tree Care to provide tree maintenance throughout 2022. (22-0106)

Updates

1. Division St. Fencing Repairs with Americana Iron Works
 - a. The contract has been signed with Americana and crews will begin work in early Spring – WJ would like them to hold off on welding new fencing until early Spring months
2. Metzger Court Updates
 - a. An additional table and two new garbage cans have been installed by Cleanslate – they have one extra table in storage for us as well
 - b. CDOT has repaired the planter and replaced the tree
 - c. LK will look into paint for the blue benches to prevent any rusting
3. Trash Cans
 - a. AH will be working with the 1st & 2nd Ward to replace and rusted trash cans in the early Spring.
4. 2022 Planter Additions
 - a. The committee would like to know if Transportation Committee is planning to install any additional streetscaping/planters this year and what those increases would look like with our vendors

1. **Christy Webber**
 - a. Crews have been salting and clearing sidewalks with no complaints of patios so far.

- b. Landscaping is complete for the season – winter planters are done and they are solely focused on snow removal.
