**1. Updates**

- a. SSA bike pumps
  - i. 3 pumps were initially installed in 2018 – staff has worked with Cleanslate to maintain and replace any broken parts. The pump at The Polish Triangle has been destroyed and needs to be replaced.
  - ii. AH suggested ordering additional pumps to install in other parts of the neighborhood, potentially by 606 trail entrances.
  - iii. MT and JH were in favor of installing near businesses to deter vandalism.

**Motion 1:** The Transportation committee moves to approve funding not to exceed **\$3,700** from line item **5.04 (Bicycle Safety Programs)** to purchase three new bike pumps from Dero. (22-1105)

**2. Discussion**

- a. AH updated the committee on BACP's permitting structures and changes that will happen in 2023 that will help save on future permit fees.
- b. AH discussed the idea of assisting with funding community bike rides held by local bike shops to promote safe city-biking habits.
  - i. The Committee was in favor of this – staff will work out details to bring to the committee in early 2023.
- c. CDOT meeting
  - i. The Committee would like to organize a sit-down meeting with CDOT to discuss ongoing concerns within the group including: speed feedback signs, raised pedestrian crosswalks, and reducing speed limits.
    - 1. Staff will work on organizing this for December or Jan 2023.
