Proposals

1. The committee did not have quorum but reviewed the following proposals for the 2022-23 season to recommend for Commission approval:

<u>Motion 1:</u> The Clean & Green Committee recommends to approve funding not to exceed \$307,300 from line item 2.08 (Sidewalk Maintenance) for Cleanslate to provide litter removal services, including After Dark in 2023. (22-1101)

<u>Motion 2:</u> The Clean & Green Committee recommends to approve funding not to exceed \$52,000 from line item 2.11 (Graffiti Abatement) for Cleanslate to provide graffiti removal services two days per week in 2023. (22-1102)

<u>Motion 3:</u> The Clean & Green Committee recommends to approve funding not to exceed \$43,500 from line item **2.02 (Landscaping)** for Bartlett Tree Services to provide tree maintenance for all of the SSA in 2023. (22-1103)

<u>Motion 4:</u> The Clean & Green Committee recommends to approve funding not to exceed \$53,700 from line item **2.02 (Landscaping)** for Christy Webber to provide litter removal, including After Dark for all of the SSA in 2023. (22-1104)

- 2. The Committee would like Commission to review both Christy Webber and Brightview's proposals for the Milwaukee Ave. planters.
 - a. Staff will circulate both proposals to be reviewed and voted on by Commissioners.
