

# Clean & Green Committee Minutes

Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> – 9:10am-10:20am

**Motion 1:** The Clean & Green Committee recommends to approve funding not to exceed **\$396,000** from line item **2.08 (Sidewalk Maintenance & Litter Abatement)** for Cleanslate to provide snow removal and litter abatement services 7 days a week and After Dark services 2 days a week in 2025. (24-0601)

*Discussion: Committee decided to add sole snow removal services to Cleanslate's neighborhood services in the coming year, as well as extend the litter abatement services to 7 days/week in 2025.*

CB motions. MT seconds. All in favor. **Recommendation passes.**

**Motion 2:** The Clean & Green Committee recommends to approve funding not to exceed **\$18,000** from line item **2.07 (Sidewalk Litter Abatement – Supplies)** for the purchase of fifteen (15) new trash cans and trash can liners to be placed within the boundaries of SSA #33. (24-0602)

*Discussion: The Committee decided to add 15 trash can liners to the proposed motion, raising the motion for \$15,000 to \$18,000, as many existing cans have damaged/missing liners that need to be replaced.*

CB motions. MT seconds. All in favor. **Recommendation passes.**

## Updates

- 1. Milwaukee Ave Power-washing and Planter Moving for WPF**
  - a. LK assured the Committee that Milwaukee Ave would be powerwashed and planters that obstruct the footprint of Wicker Park Fest 2024 would be moved before July 25<sup>th</sup>.
- 2. WasteNot Compost Intro Program**
  - a. The Second Wave of the WasteNot Compost Intro Program for SSA pin-holding businesses was confirmed to begin in July 2024.
- 3. Bartlett Services for Wicker Park Fest Arts Area**
  - a. AH mentioned a collaboration with Bartlett to hand out seedlings/literature in the Wicker Park Fest Arts Area in connection to an installation at this year's Fest which channels the monarch butterfly migration.
- 4. "Green Tips" Information Hub**
  - a. The Committee offered more ideas for the new website's Clean & Green sections, particularly tree care maintenance for the public. They specified keeping the information succinct and printable.
