- 1. The committee discussed the Milwaukee / North / Damen intersection pilot project
 - a. The committee would like to prioritize the crosswalk from Walgreens to Starbucks and the slip lane closure
 - i. The preferences for upgrades to the slip lane include a lighter color paint and greenery in planters
 - 1. JW/MA will check with CDOT on the restrictions for planters, etc.
 - 2. JW/MA will price out planters

 - d. Fence Repair is almost complete, the contractor found some other fences in need of repair and will complete those. Then Cleanslate will paint.
